**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR NATURE EDUCATION FACILITY
GRANT FUNDS UNDER THE SAFE DRINKING WATER, WATER QUALITY
AND SUPPLY, FLOOD CONTROL, RIVER AND COASTAL PROTECTION
BOND ACT OF 2006 (PROPOSITION 84)**

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of the Nature Education Facilities Program, setting up necessary procedures governing the Application; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution approval of the application(s) by the applicant's governing board before submission of said application(s) to the State; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond wishes to further plan and develop its existing Central Richmond Greenway project parkland for purposes of nature education; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant, if selected, will enter into a contract with the State of California to complete the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application for the City of Richmond to the Nature Education Facility Program Funds; and
2. Certifies that said applicant has or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on the Central Richmond Greenway project included in this application, the sufficient funds to complete the project should this grant be awarded; and
3. Certifies that applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project; and
4. Certifies that the applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the grant Administration Guide; and
5. Certifies that the project is consistent with all applicable City planning documents, as case may be; and
6. Delegates the authority to and appoints the City of Richmond's City Manager or said City Manager's designee(s), as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests, which may be necessary for completion of the aforementioned project.
7. Authorizes acceptance and appropriate of all grant funds, provided that any required matching funds have been identified in the City's budget.
8. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines.
