

**RESOLUTION NO. 113 -10**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$271,481 FROM THE  
2009-2010 FY BUDGET TO THE 2010-2011 FY BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond had allocated funds in the final approved budget for fiscal year 2009-2010 in the amount of \$271,481. These funds were allocated for the purposes of enhancing the Computer Aided Dispatch (505-97321) components of the consolidated radio system operated by the city for the consortium of west county police agencies. These funds were not encumbered in the FY 2009-2010 and therefore were not transferred into the 2010-2011 FY proposed budget.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond continues to maintain the funds for this project, it is imperative that these funds be transferred to the FY 2010-2011 budget so that vital equipment can be purchased to allow the enhancement of the Computer Aided Dispatch center along with other components of the West Contra Costa County radio system

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond Police Chief submits to the City Council a request that the funds, dedicated for this project be transferred to account (505-97321) titled Cad System Enhancement in the 2010-2011 budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL** of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall transfer the amount of \$271,481.00 in FY 2009-2010 (account 505-97321) to the same account (505-97321) in the 2010-2011 FY proposed budget.
2. The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish an Organization/Object Code in the Munis System for the deposit of the funds which have been allocated for this project.
3. The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries, which are required by state law.
