

RESOLUTION NO. 122-10

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF RICHMOND, CA
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A \$228,488 GRANT AWARD FROM
THE CALIFORNIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (CAL-EMA)**

WHEREAS, The Richmond Police Department ("City") applied for and received an allocation of funds through the California Emergency Management Agency ("CAL EMA"); and,

WHEREAS, The Cal EMA awarded the City a \$228,488 grant ("Grant"), which includes a match in-kind of \$57,122 from the City, for the development of a Victims Advocacy Program within the Richmond Police Department with on-site domestic violence advocates and sexual assault advocates from January 1, 2010-December 31, 2010; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Richmond City Council authorizes the Richmond Police Department to accept these funds and expend the Grant funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application and in accordance with all program regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council on behalf of the City authorizes the Richmond Police Department to negotiate and execute all agreements, along with any amendments and other documents required by the Cal EMA, to meet the obligations of the Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take immediate effect from and after its passage.
