

RESOLUTION NO.134-10

RESOLUTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA APPROPRIATING PROCEEDS FROM THE QUALIFIED ENERGY CONSERVATION BOND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010 – 2011

WHEREAS, The City Council authorized the issuance of \$1,052,000 in Qualified Energy Conservation Bonds (QECBs) at the November 16th, 2010 City Council meeting;

WHEREAS, proceeds of these bonds will finance three projects that were included in the original bond application including 1.) A loan to Solar Richmond to finance energy efficiency improvements at their training facility, and 2.) Funding to upgrade and repair existing lighting and HVAC systems with more energy efficient technology in all municipal facilities, and 3.) Funding to replace aging series street light systems;

WHEREAS, Council must approve an increase in budget appropriations in order to begin to expend the funds on the following projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council authorizes proceeds from the Qualified Energy Conservation Bond to be appropriated and expended by the City Manager’s Office in FY 2010-2011.
