A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA ORDERING PREPARATION OF AN ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012 REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS AND COSTS FOR THE HILLTOP LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 91-98 dated June 23, 1998, the City Council of the City of Richmond established for the Hilltop Landscape Maintenance Assessment District rates assessment and authorized annual increases thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Richmond now wishes to determine whether the rates of assessment for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 should be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) The Engineer shall prepare a report that describes any proposed new improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements.
