

RESOLUTION NO. 7-11

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA DESIGNATING OFFICIALS THAT ARE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL AND STATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR POST DISASTER MITIGATION UNDER THE NATURAL DISASTER ASSISTANCE ACT

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that the individuals holding the position titles listed below are hereby authorized to execute for, and submit in behalf of, the City of Richmond, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, application to the California Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of obtaining certain federal financial assistance under P.L. 93-288 as amended by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988, federal and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act:

1. City Manager
2. Finance Director
3. Emergency Services Manager

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Richmond, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California hereby authorizes its agent(s) to provide to the California Emergency Management Agency for all matters pertaining to such state disaster assistance the assurances and agreements required. This is a universal resolution and is effective for all open and future disasters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 12-95, adopted January 23, 1995, is hereby rescinded.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED, that this resolution shall remain in effect until such time as it is rescinded by the City Council of the City of Richmond.
