**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
APPROVING APPLICATIONS FOR STATEWIDE PARK PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of the Statewide Park Program, setting up necessary procedures governing Applications for Statewide Park Program Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications before submission of said applications to the State; and

WHEREAS, parks and green spaces within core urban neighborhoods of the City of Richmond are in need of vast improvements for which the Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program of 2008 can provide suitable grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond, as applicant, will enter into a contract with the State of California to complete the grant scope projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby:

1. Approves the filing of applications for improvements, additions to and renovations of Martin Luther King Jr. Park, Richmond Greenway, and Wendell Park; and
2. Certifies that said applicant has or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on the projects included in this application, the sufficient funds to complete the projects; and
3. Certifies that the applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the projects; and
4. Certifies that the applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide; and
5. Delegates the authority to City of Richmond's City Manager or said City Manager's designee(s) to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the grant scope;
6. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines; and
7. Authorizes the City Manager or his designee to accept and appropriate all grants awarded, and to appropriate all required matching funds described in a Council-approved budget.
