

RESOLUTION NO. 49-11

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF ADDITIONAL
FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE CITY FROM BAY AREA UASI FOR TECHNICAL
URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE TRAINING**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department, applied to Bay Area UASI for funding for technical Urban Search and Rescue training for the City of Richmond and other West County Fire Agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department was previously awarded funding during the Fiscal Year 2010 in the amount of \$74,300 by Bay Area UASI for the purpose of said training; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Richmond approved the acceptance and appropriation the funds in Resolution 99-10; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department accepted and appropriated the funds as follows in the Fiscal Year 2010:

Low Angle Rope Rescue Operational	\$14,300
Confined Space Rescue	\$22,400
Rescue Systems I	\$21,500
Trench Rescue	\$16,100

WHEREAS, Bay Area UASI amended the MOU on April 1, 2011, to reflect additional funding of \$79,200 for a total grant award of \$153,500; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department desires to accept and appropriate an additional \$79,200 to the following certification classes:

Water Rescue Training
Rope Technician I/ II Training
Rescue Systems II

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall accept the amended MOU with the Bay Area UASI for a total grant award of \$153,500, resulting in new grant funds of \$79,200.
2. The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards the purchase of the training services, in an account to be established by the Finance Department.
3. The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Budget Supplemental Fund account string for the deposit of the funds, which have been allocated to the City of Richmond.
4. The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
5. The City Manager, or his designee, shall negotiate and execute all agreements necessary for the implementation of this resolution.
