

RESOLUTION NO. 90-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$684,000 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$684,000 IN THE 2011-12 EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2011-2012 City of Richmond budget, Employment and Training received a \$400,000 Department of Labor NEG grant via the California State Employment Development Department (EDD) and was also awarded a grant from Chevron Corporation in the amount of \$100,000 and was awarded a grant from the California Energy Commission in the amount of \$134,000, and was also awarded a grant from Bechtel Corporation in the amount of \$50,000, and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$684,000 for two years will be used to serve dislocated workers (NEG On-the-Job Training) and at-risk youth up to age 18 and young adults ages 19 to 24 (YouthBuild Educational Component of the Muir Career Technical Academy) and graduates of the RichmondBuild Green Careers Academy (Clean Energy On-the-Job-Training) and Richmond youth (YouthWorks Academic Program) with employment and training services, academic enhancement services, and training for adult jobseekers

WHEREAS, this grant funding represents an opportunity to expand academic and training services for at-risk youth and job training, employment services for dislocated workers, and training services for RichmondBuild graduates and other jobseekers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2011-2012 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$684,000 to revenue and to add \$684,000 to expenditures on staffing, support services, and contractual services for training and job placement for eligible Richmond residents.
