**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA
APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF THE FY 2011 TFCA REGIONAL FUND GRANT
APPLICATION TO THE BAY AREA AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR
THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SHUTTLE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has submitted an application to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) for grant funds to support shuttle services in the City to improve public transportation throughout the City and Bay Area region;

WHEREAS, the City has identified and disclosed matching funds in the application towards project management costs to support outreach/marketing and operational costs associated with the implementation of services that are consistent with BAAQMD guidelines;

WHEREAS, a shuttle service would improve the quality of life, and provide for the mobility of people and performance that affects air quality, environmental resource consumption, social equity, and safety;

WHEREAS, the proposed shuttle project is an effective and efficient way of operating, managing, maintaining, and financing shuttle service for the City of Richmond;

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond desires to apply for, accept and appropriate up to \$315,000.00 in funding for shuttle services to ensure mobility for its residents;

WHEREAS, the grant application submitted to the Air District from the City of Richmond identifies the required 10 percent local match for this project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the City of Richmond to apply for, accept, and appropriate, if awarded, up to \$365,000.00 in TFCA funds including the 10 percent local match for shuttle service as described in the TFCA grant application.
