RESOLUTION OF INTENTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR JULY 18, 2006 TO CONSIDER THE LEVY OF AN ASSESSMENT FOR THE HILLTOP LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Richmond, by Resolution NO. 91-98, adopted on June 23, 1998, approved and adopted the Engineer’s Report, established the rate of assessment, authorized annual increases thereof, and ordered maintenance services within the Hilltop Landscape Maintenance District; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 12.60.240 of the Richmond Municipal Code, the City Engineer has caused to be prepared a report of assessments in the maintenance district for the 2006-2007 fiscal year, and;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 12.60.250 of the Richmond Municipal Code, a copy of the report will be mailed to all owners of property subject to the annual benefit assessment; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 12.60.270 of the Richmond Municipal Code, the City Engineer has filed the report with the City Clerk, together with any property owner response forms returned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that the Call for Hearing is approved to consider the annual benefit assessments that are proposed to be levied.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing shall be held at the regularly scheduled meeting on July 18, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. at the Council Chambers located at 1401 Marina Way South, Richmond, CA 94804 at which time the City Council will hear protests and will consider and finally act upon the Engineer’s Report.
