

**RESOLUTION NO. 9-12**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND  
ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENDOWMENT AND  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO ALL REQUIRED  
CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS TO FACILITATE THE GRANT OUTCOMES**

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond has drafted the Community Health and Wellness Element (HWE) and completed the pilot implementation of the HWE with support from The California Endowment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond anticipates building on successful investments in Richmond by The California Endowment through the Richmond Health Equity Partnership project grant proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond Health Equity Partnership will develop a collaborative partnership between the City of Richmond, Contra Costa Health Services (CCHS), and the West Contra Costa Unified School District (WCCUSD) to advance health equity for children and families through the development of a Health in All Policies strategy and Full-Service Community Schools strategy in Richmond for duplication in other cities and areas of West Contra Costa County; and

**WHEREAS**, this project will develop new partnerships, joint-strategies and policies that will enable the systems change that will reduce health disparities and better support the efforts of residents and community-based organizations in achieving improved health and equity goals; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Richmond accepts a grant from The California Endowment to assist in funding the Richmond Health Equity Partnership; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Richmond authorizes the City Manager to enter into all necessary contracts and agreements with CCHS, WCCUSD, Professor Jason Corburn, and other consultants to complete the scope of work.
