**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF \$103,081 FUNDS AWARDED THE CITY
THROUGH THE 2011 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT
(JAG) GRANT FUND TO SUPPLEMENT LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Federal government has made funds available under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Fund through the Office of Justice Programs (OJP) Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County of Contra Costa has been designated as a disparate jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Contra Costa County Office of the Sheriff will serve as the applicant FISCAL AGENT, and GRANTEE, for the joint funds awarded.

WHEREAS, under the allocations, the City of Richmond is identified as a SUBGRANTEE and entitled to a maximum amount of \$103,081 for law enforcement equipment purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State of California requires that the City Council hold a public meeting to consider the Police Chief's request for funding; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Police Chief has submitted to the City Council a request that the funds, which the City will receive under the allocations, be used for equipment costs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$ 103,081 from the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Fund.
2. The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards equipment costs.
3. The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Fund Organization/Object Code in the Munis System for the deposit of the funds which have been allocated to the City of Richmond from the 2011 JAG.
4. The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by state law.
