

RESOLUTION NO. 64-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE RICHMOND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE PETITION, BALLOT, AND OTHER DOCUMENTS IN SUPPORT OF THE PROPOSED DOWNTOWN RICHMOND PROPERTY & BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the property owners within the downtown commercial core propose formation of the Downtown Richmond Property and Business Improvement District (DRPBID) pursuant to the Property and Business Improvement Law of 1994, California Streets and Highways Code section 36600 et seq., which authorizes cities to establish property and business improvement districts for the purposes of promoting economic revitalization and financing activities and services to improve the overall economic climate in said districts; and

WHEREAS, the City owns several properties within the proposed DRPBID, a list of which is attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the public interest will be served by having these City properties participate in the DRPBID.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to sign all documents on behalf of the City of Richmond in support of the DRPBID:
