

RESOLUTION NO. 90-12

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF A \$75,000 FY 2013 GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL FOR THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AND AUTHORIZATION AND APPROPRIATION FOR \$24,500 PERSONNEL COSTS AS MATCHING CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS THE GRANT

WHEREAS, the State of California has appropriated grant monies for FY 2013 to address issues of crimes related to problem alcohol beverage establishments in various cities.

WHEREAS, the grants are administered by California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC);

WHEREAS, under this program, the City of Richmond has been offered a \$75,000 reimbursement-type ABC “Gap” grant;

WHEREAS, the Richmond Police Department is committed to reducing the crimes related to problem alcohol beverage establishments within its geographical jurisdiction, and hereby desires to avail itself of the ABC “Gap” grant;

WHEREAS, the funding agency requires that the City supply a matching contribution of \$24,500 toward this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City does hereby authorize the acceptance and appropriation of a \$75,000 ABC “Gap” grant from the State of California, and the appropriation of \$24,500 in personnel costs as matching contributions toward the following grant line-item budget:

Total Grant Budget	<u>\$99,500</u>
