**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF A \$178,979 GRANT
AWARD FROM THE CALIFORNIA EMERGENCY MANGEMENT AGENCY (CAL-EMA)**

WHEREAS, the Richmond Police Department (Agency) applied for and received an allocation of grant funds through the California Emergency Management Agency (CAL-EMA); and

WHEREAS, CAL-EMA awarded the Agency a \$178,979 grant, which includes a match in-kind of \$59,660 from the City to maintain a victims advocacy program within the Richmond Police Department with onsite domestic violence advocates from January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council authorizes the Richmond Police Department to accept these funds and expend the grant funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application and in accordance with all program regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council on behalf of the Agency authorizes the Agency to negotiate and execute all agreements, along with any amendments and associated documents required by CAL-EMA to meet the obligations of the grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take immediate effect from and after passage.
