**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE FULL-COST ALLOCATION PLAN FOR FY
2009-10 AND OMB A-87 COST ALLOCATION PLAN FOR FY 2008-09**

WHEREAS, implementation of the cost allocation plans allows for reimbursement of indirect costs for services provided by central service departments to other City departments and federal grants programs pursuant to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-87; and

WHEREAS, the following are central service departments: Office of the Mayor, City Council, City Manager, City Clerk, City Attorney, Finance, and Human Resources; and

WHEREAS, the cost allocation plans identify the total cost of providing administrative services to other City departments in support of their operations; and

WHEREAS, indirect costs, as opposed to direct costs, are the costs of delivering specific types of services but are not directly associated with one type of cost objective.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby adopts the Full-Cost Allocation Plan and OMB A-87 Cost Allocation Plan.
