

RESOLUTION NO. 34-13

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AND THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE FY 2012 UASI GRANT FUNDS THROUGH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department is establishing a Marine Emergency Response Program to provide public safety services on the waters surrounding the City of Richmond and the San Francisco Bay, and

WHEREAS, the emergency response services may include search and rescue missions that will require enhanced visual searches for victims, and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department has applied to the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) for funding to purchase binoculars and a storage container to store and properly secure rescue equipment, and

WHEREAS, San Francisco has been designated as the grantee and fiscal agent for the Bay Area Urban Area Approval Authority (Approval Authority), by the Department of Homeland Security through the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal-EMA) with responsibility to execute sub-grant agreements for distribution of UASI program grant funds, and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$32,300 has been authorized by the Approval Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

- The City of Richmond shall accept the reimbursement funds of \$32,300 from the City and County San Francisco.
- The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards the purchase of binoculars and a storage container for use as part of the Marine Emergency Response Program.
- The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Budget Supplemental Fund revenue account string for the deposit of the funds, and a corresponding expense account string for expenditures, which will be reimbursed to the City of Richmond.
- The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
- The City Manager, or his designee, shall negotiate and execute all agreements necessary for the implementation of this Resolution.
