

RESOLUTION NO. 41-13

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RICHMOND CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TARGETED EMPLOYMENT AREA FOR
THE CITY OF RICHMOND ENTERPRISE ZONE**

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2007, the City of Richmond Enterprise Zone received its final designation of a new 15-year Enterprise Zone designation from the California Department of Housing and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise Zones may designate census tracts located within the boundaries of cities and counties that have jurisdiction over an Enterprise Zone as a Targeted Employment Area, provided that at least 51% of the tract's residents are low-or moderate-income, using the most recent US Census Data; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise Zone staff has determined that the following census tracts, as defined by the United States Department of Census, within the County of Contra Costa are eligible for inclusion in the Targeted Employment Area: 6013360101, 6013360200, 6013361000, 6013362000, 6013363000, 6013365002, 6013365003, 6013367100, 6013367200, 6013369002, 6013370000, 6013371000, 6013372000, 6013373000, 6013374000, 6013375000, 6013376000, 6013377000, 6013378000, 6013379000, 6013380000, 6013381000, 6013382000, 6013383000, 6013386000, and 6013392200.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, City of Richmond supports the establishment of a Targeted Employment Area for the Richmond Enterprise Zone within the census tracts identified above, subject to final approval by the California Department of Housing and Community Development.
