**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND  
APPROVING A 1.7% INCREASE TO THE PORT OF RICHMOND TERMINAL  
TARIFF FMC NO. 3.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond operates various terminal facilities at the Port of Richmond; and

**WHEREAS**, On April 24, 2013 the California Association of Port Authorities Committee on Tariffs and Practices approved a GRI (General Rate Increase) implementation of 1.7% for all Ports in the State of California and it is desirable to increase the Port of Richmond Terminal Tariff FMC No. 3 by implementing a one point seven percent tariff rate increase effective July 1, 2013.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby adopts an amendment to the Port of Richmond Terminal Tariff FMC No. 3 increasing the tariff by one point seven (1.7) percent effective July 1, 2013 and authorizes the City's Port Director to publish the rates and rules, as required.
