**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA
APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF
RICHMOND AND IFPTE LOCAL 21**

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated in good faith with IFPTE Local 21 regarding terms of a new Memorandum of Understanding (MOU); and

WHEREAS, the parties reached a Tentative Agreement on terms for a new MOU on July 18, 2013, replacing the current MOU which expired on June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, that Tentative Agreement shall not bind the parties until it is ratified by a majority of IFPTE Local 21 membership and ratified by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the tentative agreement will establish a new MOU, effective July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this agreement will support a stable and amicable labor relations environment in the City; and

WHEREAS, there is a positive impact of a three-year MOU on the City's ability to plan its finance and budget;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Richmond authorizes reduction of the parties' July 18, 2013 Tentative Agreement to final Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) language, the terms of which are set forth and marked as Exhibit A of this resolution.
