

RESOLUTION NO. 109-13

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AND THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE FY 2013 UASI GRANT FUNDS THROUGH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department along with other Contra Costa County Fire Agencies have established an Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) Program to provide emergency rescue services to the City of Richmond and the greater West Contra Costa County area, and

WHEREAS, the emergency response services may include search and rescue missions that will require a heavy rescue vehicle, and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department has applied to the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) for funding to purchase a heavy rescue vehicle for use as part of the West Contra Costa County USAR Program, and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco has been designated as the grantee and fiscal agent for the Bay Area Urban Area Approval Authority (Approval Authority) established as the Urban Area Working Group (UAWG) for the UASI Region, to provide overall governance of the homeland security grant program across the UASI Region, to coordinate development and implementation of all UASI program initiatives, and to ensure compliance with all UASI program requirements; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$300,000 has been authorized by the Approval Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

- The City of Richmond shall accept the reimbursement grant funds of \$300,000 from the City and County of San Francisco.
- The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards the purchase of a heavy rescue vehicle for use as part of the West Contra Costa County USAR Program.
- The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Budget Supplemental Fund revenue account string for the deposit of the funds, and a corresponding expense account string for expenditures, which will be reimbursed to the City of Richmond.
- The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
- The City Manager, or his designee, shall negotiate and execute all agreements necessary for the implementation of this Resolution.
