

RESOLUTION NO. 109-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A TITLE II
FORMULA GRANT FOR A DELINQUENCY PREVENTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has identified violence prevention as an important priority for the City of Richmond, and has established the Office of Violence Prevention as a key element in its efforts to address this issue; and

WHEREAS, the Title II Formula Grants Program administered by the Corrections Standards Authority (hereinafter referred to as "CSA") of the State of California is soliciting proposals to fund delinquency prevention projects in local communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Office of Violence Prevention, in conjunction with other City departments, community-based organizations, and county departments including the Contra Costa County Probation Department, desires to receive and use federal grant funds available through the Title II Formula Grants Program administered by the CSA to support a delinquency prevention program providing aftercare services for youth re-entering the community following confinement in a correctional facility or other out of home placement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the City Manager of the City of Richmond to submit on behalf of the City of Richmond a Title II Formula Grants application and to sign the Grant Agreement with the CSA, including any amendments thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Richmond Office of Violence Prevention agrees to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the Title II Formula Grants Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the CSA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received under the Title II Formula Grants Program shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
