**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA ORDERING PREPARATION OF THE ANNUAL ENGINEER'S
REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS AND
COSTS FOR THE MARINA BAY LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE
DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 83-09 dated July 28, 2009, the City Council of the City of Richmond established assessment rates for the Marina Bay Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District and authorized annual increases thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Richmond now wishes to determine whether the rates of assessment for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 should be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) The Engineer shall prepare a report that describes any proposed new improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements.

(2) The Engineer shall file the report with the City Clerk for consideration by the City Council.
