

**RESOLUTION NO. 32-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND CALIFORNIA  
ESTABLISHING A FOUR-WAY STOP AT 33<sup>rd</sup> STREET AND CLINTON AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV, to wit:

WHEREAS, due to excessive speeding and traffic accidents, a four-way stop is needed at the 33<sup>rd</sup> and Clinton Avenue intersection, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 of the Richmond Municipal Code the Richmond City Council desires that the intersection of 33<sup>rd</sup> Street and Clinton Avenue be declared a four-way stop so that all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Council of the City of Richmond that the City Engineer is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersection of 33<sup>rd</sup> Street and Clinton Avenue as indicated in the above recitals.
