

RESOLUTION NO. 50-14

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
CERTIFYING THE GRANT-FUNDED PORT OF RICHMOND HIGH-MAST
SECURITY LIGHTING PROJECT AS COMPLETE**

WHEREAS, in 2008, the City of Richmond (“City”) was awarded \$2,650,000.00 in grant funds from the California Port and Maritime Security Grant Program to be used for lighting improvement work at the Port of Richmond; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2010, the City circulated an Invitation to Bid seeking contractors willing to undertake the construction of the Port of Richmond High-Mast Security Lighting Project at Point Potrero Marine Terminal (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, after a competitive process, on September 7, 2010, the City Council selected Rosendin Electric, Inc. (“Rosendin”) as lowest responsive bidder to furnish construction and related services for the Project in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,560,000.00; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2013, the City issued a Notice of Completion indicating that all Project requirements had been completed; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the capitalization of the Project in the City’s financial management system, the City Council is required to certify the Project as complete; and

WHEREAS, by the Agenda Report submitted in support of this Resolution, the City Council has been provided with additional information upon which the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution are based.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served, together with the Agenda Report, as the basis for the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby certifies the Port of Richmond High-Mast Security Lighting Project as complete.
