

RESOLUTION NO. 84-14

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF \$50,000 FUNDS AWARDED THE CITY OF RICHMOND AND CITY OF SAN PABLO THROUGH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL (ABC) TO ADDRESS CRIMES RELATED TO PROBLEM ALCOHOL BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS IN RICHMOND AND SAN PABLO, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the State of California has appropriated grant monies for FY 2014/15 to address issues of crimes related to problem alcohol beverage establishments in Richmond, California and San Pablo, California.

WHEREAS, the grants are administered by California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC);

WHEREAS, under this program, the City of Richmond and City of San Pablo has been collectively awarded a \$50,000 reimbursement-type ABC "GAP" Grant;

WHEREAS, the Richmond Police Department is committed to reducing the crimes related to problem alcohol beverage establishments within its geographical jurisdiction, and hereby desires to avail itself of the ABC "GAP" Grant;

WHEREAS, the Richmond Police Chief has submitted to the City Council a request that the funds, which the City will receive under the allocations, be used to address issues of crimes related to problem alcohol beverage establishments in Richmond, California and San Pablo, California.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$50,000 from the State of California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC).
2. The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards operating expenses, equipment and personnel salaries between the Richmond Police Department and San Pablo Police Department.
3. The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Fund Organization/Object Code in MUNIS System for the deposit of the funds which have been allocated to the City of Richmond from the State of California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) "GAP" Grand Fund.
4. The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by state law.
