A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO INCREASE AMENDING THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT BUDGET TO INCREASE REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$220

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Recreation Department received a donation in the amount of \$220.00 from the Parents of May Valley Community Center to support the Kids in Motion Summer Camp program on July 24, 2014 and August 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$110.00 was used by the May Valley Community Center Kids in Motion Summer Camp program towards the payment of the Parks Express Bus service offered by East Bay Regional Park District to Contra Loma Regional Park based on participation; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$110.00 was used by the May Valley Community Center Kids in Motion Summer Camp program towards the payment of Parks Express Bus service offered by East Bay Regional Park District to Cull Canyon Regional Park based on participation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the Recreation Department Budget be adjusted to increase expenditures by \$220.
