A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE HILLTOP LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT BUDGET TO TRANSFER RESERVE FUNDS INTO THE OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2014, the Richmond City Council approved the FY 2014-15 budget for the Hilltop Landscape Maintenance District (“District”) and the annual engineers report prepared by Willdan Financial Services (“Report”) for the District; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment is needed to transfer \$75,000.00 from the reserve fund to the operating budget for the Hilltop Landscape Maintenance District; and

WHEREAS, the \$75,000 will be used for two proposed Capital Improvement Beautification Projects along the Richmond Parkway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Council of the City of Richmond that the Hilltop Landscape Maintenance District budget for FY 2014-15 be amended to reflect the transfer from the reserve fund.
