**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
ESTABLISHING FOUR-WAY STOP FOR TWO (2) INTERSECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV to enhance the safety at the two intersections, and

WHEREAS, traffic studies were conducted for the two intersections listed below, and those traffic study results meet the criteria for Stop Control installation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 of the Richmond Municipal Code the following intersections are declared a four-way stop and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

- 1. 35th Street and Solano Avenue
- 2. 35th Street and Clinton Avenue

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that the Public Works Director is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersections as listed above.
