

CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 71-15

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY
OF RICHMOND AND CONTRA COSTA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR
REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH MARITIME RESPONSE
EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department, applied to the California Office of Emergency Services for funding for the purchase of maritime response and training equipment for the City of Richmond and for use regionally for interoperability training; and

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office (CCSO) has been appointed by the California Office of Emergency Services to act on its behalf for coordinating and managing State Homeland Security Grant Program funds and for reimbursing agencies for authorized equipment expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department (RFD) would like to enter into agreement with CCSO which would allow reimbursement of costs for pre-approved marine response and training equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

- The City of Richmond shall accept the reimbursement funds of \$25,000 from Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office.
- The funds that the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards the purchase of the marine response and training equipment, from an account to be established by the Finance Department.
- The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Budget Supplemental Fund account string and project code for the deposit of the funds, which will be reimbursed to the City of Richmond.
- The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries that are required by State law.
- The City Manager, or his designee, shall negotiate and execute all agreements necessary for the implementation of this resolution.
