**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING ACTION TO BE TAKEN UNDER THE RICHMOND MUNICIPAL
CODE, SECTION 14.28.010 TO ESTABLISH FOUR-WAY STOPS AT THE
DESIGNATED INTERSECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV, to wit:

In accordance with Section 14.28.010 of the Richmond Municipal Code the following twenty seven (28) intersections are declared for four-way stop and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

4. 24th Street and Lowell Avenue
5. 24th Street and Wendell Avenue
6. 25th Street and Bush Avenue
7. 25th Street and Pine Avenue
8. 26th Street and Bush Avenue
9. 26th Street and Pine Avenue
10. 28th Street and Moran Avenue
11. 28th Street and Wendell Avenue
12. 29th Street and Tulare Street
13. 32nd Street and Andrade Avenue
14. 32nd Street and Humphrey Avenue
15. 32nd Street and Lowell Avenue
16. 34th Street and Andrade Avenue
17. 34th Street and Humphrey Avenue
18. So. 27th Street and Virginia Avenue
19. So. 27th Street and Maine Avenue
20. So. 37th Street and Wall Avenue
21. So. 39th Street and Center Avenue
22. Amend Road and Devils Drop Court
23. Amend Road and Facination Circle
24. Amend Road and Garrison Road
25. Hayes Street and Bush Avenue
26. Hayes Street and Emeric Avenue
27. Hayes Street and Pine Avenue
28. Moyers Road and Benjamin Drive
