

**CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 1-16**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF \$150,000 AWARDED TO THE CITY THROUGH THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS 2015 BODY-WORN POLICY AND IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM GRANT TO PURCHASE BODY-WORN CAMERAS AND EQUIPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal government has made funds available through the Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs (OJP) Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for law enforcement purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond is identified as a GRANTEE and entitled to a maximum of \$150,000 for the purchase of body-worn cameras and equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond will provide staff support and equipment in-kind matching funds of \$150,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California requires the City Council hold a public meeting to consider the Police Chief's request for funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond Police Chief has submitted to the City Council a request that funds, which the City will receive under the allocations, be used for the purchase of body-worn cameras and equipment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$150,000 from the Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs Bureau of Justice Assistance.
2. The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards the purchase of body-worn cameras and equipment.
3. The City of Richmond shall allow staff support in-kind matching funds of \$137,416 and equipment in-kind matching funds of \$12,584.
4. The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Fund Organization/Object Code in the Munis System for the deposit of the funds which have been allocated to the City of Richmond from the 2015 Body-Worn Policy and Implementation Program grant.
5. The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
