

CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 69-16

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THE CANVASS OF RETURNS AND RESULT OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 7, 2016

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Richmond duly called and ordered held in said City a Special Election, consolidated with the Primary Election, for two measures as follows:

“Shall the ordinance to amend the Richmond General Plan 2030 to allow a 59 unit single family detached project on a site south of the intersection of Marina Way South and Hall and approve a development agreement and related actions be adopted?”

"Shall the ordinance to amend the Richmond Municipal Code requiring the City Manager to publicize compensation paid to exempt City service officials and employees, obligating the City Council to set annual compensation for City exempt service officials and employees and prohibiting the City Council from compensating the City Manager in excess of five times the median household income for the City be adopted?"

WHEREAS, said Primary Election was held on Tuesday, June 7, 2016, in accordance with law and the Charter of said City and with Chapter 2.16 of the Municipal Code of the City of Richmond, and the votes thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof ascertained, determined and declared in all respects as required by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond, as follows:

- 1. That the statement of the County Clerk of the County of Contra Costa of the votes casts, set forth in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, is hereby approved and adopted and is hereby entered on the Minutes of this Council as a statement of the result of said election.
2. That at said Primary Election the following measures received a majority of the votes cast opposing and supporting said measures and were, duly defeated, to wit:

Measure N – Riviera Project

“Shall the ordinance to amend the Richmond General Plan 2030 to allow a 59 unit single family detached project on a site south of the intersection of Marina Way South and Hall and approve a development agreement and related actions be adopted?”

Measure O – Compensation Levels




