

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-16**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF \$115,000 AWARDED TO THE CITY THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY (OTS) FOR IMPAIRED DRIVING ENFORCEMENT**

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**WHEREAS**, the State of California has appropriated grant monies for FY2016/17 to address issues of crime related to impaired driving in Richmond, California; and

**WHEREAS**, the grants are administered by the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS); and

**WHEREAS**, under this program, the City of Richmond has been awarded a \$115,000 reimbursement-type Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond Police Department is committed to reducing crimes related to impaired driving, within its geographical jurisdiction, and desires to avail itself of the OTS STEP grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California requires the City Council hold a public meeting to consider the Police Chief's request for funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond Police Chief has submitted to the City Council a request that funds, which the City will receive under the allocations, be used to address issues of crime related to impaired driving in Richmond, California.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$115,000 from the California Department of Office of Traffic Safety (OTS).
2. The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards personnel services, operating expenses, equipment purchases, and travel costs by the Richmond Police Department.
3. The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Fund Organization/Object Code in the Munis System for the deposit of the funds which have been allocated to the City of Richmond from the California Department of Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) STEP Grant Fund.
4. The Police Accountant of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
