**AUTHORIZING ACTION TO INSTALL A FOUR-WAY STOP AT 8TH STREET
AND BISSELL AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV, to wit:

In accordance with Section 14.28.010 of the Richmond Traffic Code the intersection of 8th Street and Bissell Avenue is declared a four-way stop and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED Resolution No. 190-81 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the City Engineer is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersection of 8th Street and Bissell Avenue as indicated above.
