

**CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 16-17**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE  
STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT HOUSING-RELATED PARKS GRANT AND EXECUTE FUNDING  
AGREEMENTS, IF APPLICATION IS APPROVED**

**WHEREAS**, the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD or Department) has issued a Notice of Funding Availability dated November 16, 2016 (NOFA), under its Housing-Related Parks (HRP) Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond desires to apply for a HRP Program grant and submit the 2016 Designated Program Year Application Package released by the HCD; and

**WHEREAS**, the HCD is authorized to approve funding allocations for the HRP Program, subject to the terms and conditions of the NOFA, Program Guidelines, Application Package, and Standard Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Richmond:

1. Appoints the City Manager, or his designee, as agent to apply for and submit to the HCD the HRP Program Application Package released November 2016 for the 2016 Designated Program Year in an amount not to exceed \$2,732,700.00.
2. Authorizes and directs the City Manager to enter into, execute, and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement (Standard Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$2,732,700.00, if the City's application is approved, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to secure the HRP Program Grant from the Department, and all amendments thereto (collectively, the "HRP Grant Documents").
3. Accepts that the City of Richmond shall be subject to the terms and conditions as specified in the Standard Agreement. Funds are to be used for allowable capital asset project expenditures to be identified in Exhibit A of the Standard Agreement. The application in full is incorporated as part of the Standard Agreement. Any and all activities funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the application are enforceable through the Standard Agreement. The City of Richmond hereby agrees to use the funds for eligible capital asset(s) in the manner presented in the application as approved by the Department and in accordance with the NOFA and Program Guidelines and Application Package.
4. The City Manager is authorized to execute in the name of the City of Richmond the HRP Program Application Package and the HRP Grant Documents as required by the Department for participation in the HRP Program.
5. If awarded, authorizes acceptance and appropriation of all grant funds for the fiscal years 2017/2018 and 2018/2019.
