

RESOLUTION NO. 52-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA TO ACCEPT A 2017 STORM NATIONAL DISLOCATED WORKER GRANT FROM CALIFORNIA EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$300,000, AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$300,000 IN THE 2016-2017 EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING DEPARTMENT BUDGET, AND APPROVE HIRING OF 15 PART-TIME TEMPORARY HOURLY MAINTENANCE AIDE II POSITIONS

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2016-2017 City of Richmond budget, Employment and Training was awarded a \$300,000 grant through the California State Employment Development Department (EDD), and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$300,000 through September 30, 2018 will be used to employ dislocated workers in part-time temporary, hourly Maintenance Aide II positions supervised by the Department of Infrastructure and Maintenance Operations (DIMO), and

WHEREAS, this grant funding represents an opportunity to expand work experience and employment services for dislocated workers, and

WHEREAS, this grant funding represents an opportunity for these workers to cleanup, repair and restore public facilities damaged by 2017 storms, repair damaged roads, repair potholes, restore hillsides, restore creeks, clean out V ditches, and remove broken branches and debris.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2016-17 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$300,000 to revenue and to add \$300,000 to expenditures and job placement for eligible dislocated workers.
