A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A FOUR-WAY STOP AT SOUTH 37TH STREET AND CENTER AVENUE

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 of the Richmond Traffic Code, the City Council declares that the intersection of South 37th Street and Center Avenue is a four-way stop and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Council of the City of Richmond that the City Engineer is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersection of South 37th Street and Center Avenue as indicated above.
