A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A FOUR-WAY STOP AT  
MARINA WAY SOUTH AND HALL AVENUE

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 of the Richmond Traffic Code, the City Council declares that the intersection of Marina Way South and Hall Avenue is a four-way stop and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Council of the City of Richmond that the City Engineer is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersection of Marina Way South and Hall Avenue as indicated above.
