

RESOLUTION NO. 62-18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TWO(2) FOUR-WAY STOPS AT
BARRETT AVENUE AND KEY BOULEVARD & MACDONALD AVENUE AND KEY
BOULEVARD, AND FOR TWO (2) TWO-WAY STOPS AT ROOSEVELT AVENUE
AND KEY BOULEVARD & NEVIN AVENUE AND 36TH STREET**

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 of the Richmond Traffic Code, the City Council declares that the intersections of Barrett Avenue & Key Boulevard and Macdonald Avenue & Key Boulevard is a four-way stop and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 & 14.28.020 of the Richmond Traffic Code, the City Council declares that the intersection of Roosevelt Boulevard & Key Boulevard and the intersection of Nevin Avenue & 36th Street is a two-way stop and vehicles must stop at stop signs before entering the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Council of the City of Richmond that the City Engineer is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersections of Barrett Avenue & Key Boulevard, Macdonald Avenue & Key Boulevard, Roosevelt Boulevard & Key Boulevard and Nevin Avenue & 36th Street as indicated above.
