

RESOLUTION NO. 85-18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TWO (2) ALL-WAY STOPS AT THE T-
INTERSECTIONS AT SOUTH 55TH STREET/MARIPOSA STREET & SOUTH 55TH
STREET/HIGHLAND AVENUE RESPECTIVELY AND ONE (1) FOUR-WAY STOP AT
38TH STREET AND GARVIN AVENUE INTERSECTION**

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 & 14.28.020 of the Richmond Traffic Code, the City Council declares that the intersections of South 55th Street & Mariposa Street, South 55th St & Highland Avenue are all-way stop controls (AWSC) and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 & 14.28.020 of the Richmond Traffic Code, the City Council declares that the intersection of Garvin Avenue & 38th Street is a four-way stop and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Council of the City of Richmond that the City Engineer is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersections of South 55th Street & Mariposa Street, South 55th Street & Highland Avenue and Garvin Avenue & 38th Street as indicated above.
