

**RESOLUTION NO. 6-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL AND EXECUTION OF GRANT APPLICATION TO  
REQUEST GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE PARKS DIVISION  
OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS FOR THE POINT MOLATE BEACH PARK  
SHORELINE RESTORATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond has the authority to construct, operate, and maintain the Point Molate Beach Park Shoreline Restoration Project along Stenmark Dr.; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond is requesting up to a \$500,000 grant from the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways; and

**WHEREAS**, the north end of Beach Park along Stenmark Dr. is adjacent to and provides access to the San Francisco Bay; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond desires to enhance, repair, construct, and protect Stenmark Dr. along Beach Park, as well as protect any sewer, water, gas, electric, and storm water improvements located within the right-of-way, and to meet the vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle access needs of bay and beach users and provide other public amenities to those utilizing these facilities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the City of Richmond City Council that, pursuant and subject to all of the terms and provisions of the funding program, application be made to the State of California Division of Boating and Waterways for funding; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that the City Council of the City of Richmond:

1. Approve the filing of an application for grant funds from the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways for a Shoreline Erosion Control Grant for the Point Molate Beach Park Shoreline Restoration Project.
2. Certifies that said applicant will make adequate provisions for operation and maintenance of the project.
3. Appoints, Engineering and Capital Improvements Projects Director, as administrating agency applicant to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to: application agreements, amendments, payment requests, etc., which may be necessary for the project.
