

**RESOLUTION NO. 35-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF  
\$3,440 AWARDED TO THE CITY THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF  
JUSTICE, BUREAU OF FORENSIC SERVICES UNTESTED SEXUAL ASSAULT  
EVIDENCE GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, State Assembly Bill 3118 requires a statewide audit of all untested sexual assault evidence kits; and

**WHEREAS**, State Senate Bill 862 has made funds available for local law enforcement agencies to audit the number of untested sexual assault evidence kits in police evidence; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond has been awarded \$3,440 to audit untested sexual assault evidence kits in Richmond Police Department evidence; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California requires the City Council to hold a public meeting to consider the Police Chief's request for funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond Police Chief has submitted to the City Council a request that funds, which the City will receive under the allocations, be used for auditing purposes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$3,440 from the Untested Sexual Assault Evidence Grant Program.
2. The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards auditing costs.
3. The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Fund Organization/Object Code in the Munis System for the deposit of the funds which have been allocated to the City of Richmond from the Untested Sexual Assault Evidence Grant Program.
4. The Police Department Accountant of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
