**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF \$146,246 AWARDED TO
THE CITY THROUGH THE 2017/2018 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE
ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM TO SUPPLEMENT LAW ENFORCEMENT
SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Federal government has made funds available under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program through the Office of Justice Programs (OJP) Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County of Contra Costa County has been designated as a disparate jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa County Office of the Sheriff will serve as the applicant FISCAL AGENT and GRANTEE for the joint funds awarded; and

WHEREAS, under the allocation the City of Richmond is identified as a SUBGRANTEE and entitled to a maximum of \$146,246 for law enforcement safety equipment purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State of California requires the City Council hold a public meeting to consider the Police Chief's request for funding; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Police Chief has submitted to the City Council a request that funds, which the City will receive under the allocations, be used for safety equipment costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$146,246 from the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program.
2. The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards safety equipment costs.
3. The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Fund Organization/Object Code in the Munis System for the deposit of the funds which have been allocated to the City of Richmond from the 2017 and 2018 JAG Grant Program.
4. The Police Department Accountant of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.


