

RESOLUTION NO. 93-19

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE PROGRAM NARRATIVE AND BUDGET
AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 FOR THE 2019-2023 YOUTH REINVESTMENT GRANT
AWARDED BY THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond, through its Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS), applied for a grant award under the Youth Reinvestment Grant Program funded through the California State General Fund and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as BSCC) on March 29, 2019; and

WHEREAS, BSCC awarded a Youth Reinvestment Grant Program grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 to the City on June 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to accept and appropriate the grant award as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council accepts and appropriates the program narrative and budget in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for the 2019-2023 Youth Reinvestment Grant Award; and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into contracts for four years with the following community based organizations: Richmond Police Activities League (RPAL) (\$400,000), Youth Services Bureau (YSB) (\$250,000), Safe Return Project (\$250,000) National Council on Crime and Delinquency (NCCD) (\$10,000) annually and to execute all budgetary amendments approved by BSCC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) agrees to ensure all matching funds required for the above grant are provided and abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.
