A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO ENCROACHMENT SERVICES TO APPROPRIATE BUDGET FROM THE FUND BALANCE INTO THE OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2019, the Richmond City Council approved the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2020 budget for Encroachment Services; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment is needed to appropriate \$31,500 from the fund balance to the Operating budget for Encroachment Services; and

WHEREAS, the \$31,500 will be used to support two (2) Administrative Student Interns for eight (8) hours per week and one full time temporary Office Aide; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Richmond, California, that the Encroachment Services budget for FY 2019-2020 be amended to reflect the appropriation from the fund balance.
