

**RESOLUTION NO. 102-19**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ENFORCEMENT RESPONSE PLAN AS  
REQUIRED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

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**WHEREAS**, the Environmental Protection Agency established a regulatory requirement (40 CFR Section 403.8(f)(5)) that requires the City of Richmond to develop and approve an Enforcement Response Plan specifically for its Pretreatment Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond's Enforcement Response Plan is intended to establish a clear framework for implementing an effective enforcement program and addresses Industrial User noncompliance with applicable Pretreatment Standards and Requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond's Enforcement Response Plan provides the City, in a step-by-step fashion, the procedures to be followed in order to identify, document, and respond to pretreatment and environmental violations, and

**WHEREAS**, the Enforcement Response Plan is based upon the authorities granted to the City in Richmond Municipal Code Chapter 12.18 that governs discharges by industrial users to the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Enforcement Response Plan shall be updated in accordance with any subsequent updates of Richmond Municipal Code Chapter 12.18.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Richmond hereby approves the Enforcement Response Plan to be in compliance with 40 CFR Section 403.8(f)(5) requirements in substantially the form presented to the Council at this meeting (a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk).


