

**RESOLUTION NO. 111-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
TO ACCEPT THREE NEW FEDERAL AND STATE GRANTS AND ADJUST  
APPROPRIATIONS BY \$470,250 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$470,250 IN  
THE 2019-2020 EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the 2019-2020 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded a \$250,000 grant from the California Workforce Development Board, and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funding of \$250,000 through June 30, 2021 will be used to train 60 participants through the RichmondBUILD program, and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the 2019-2020 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded a \$20,250 grant from the California Workforce Development Board, passed through Oakland PIC, and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funding of \$20,250 through June 30, 2020 will be used as additional assistance for planning purposes for the Prison to Employment Implementation grant previously awarded, and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the 2019-2020 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded a \$200,000 grant from the Environmental Protection Agency, and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funding of \$200,000 through September 30, 2021 will be used to recruit, train and provide job placement assistance to RichmondBUILD program participants, and

**WHEREAS**, this grant funding will significantly expand access to training and job placement opportunities for Richmond residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2019-2020 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$470,250 to revenue and to add \$470,250 to expenditures.
