

**RESOLUTION NO. 112-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, FOR  
PHASE II OF EMERGENCY REPAIRS FOR THE SINK HOLE PROJECT AT VALLEY  
VIEW ROAD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$27,250  
(PROJECT COST OF \$25,000, PLUS VEOLIA 9.0%)**

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**WHEREAS**, on June 12, 2019, a significant sinkhole was detected by City of Richmond staff in the area near 4807 Valley View Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the sink hole was due to a damaged sixty-inch storm drain pipe beneath the street surface; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 17, 2019 the City Council adopted Resolution 83-19 approving the emergency repairs of the Valley View Sink Hole in the amount of \$278,116 for the sink hole repair project, including design, debris removal, traffic control, and new construction ; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the pipe liner for the project being “back-ordered”, the repair would need to be completed in two phases; and

**WHEREAS**, upon delivery of the liner, the subcontractor, in conjunction with Veolia Water, scheduled the repairs of the liner when it would cause the least impact to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, that date was determined to be October 19, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, upon site visit on October 19, 2019, the subcontractor reported to the Public Works Director, Yader Bermudez, that additional traffic controls would need to be implemented to ensure the safety of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, Traffic Management, Inc. was subcontracted by BayHawk (managed by Veolia) to provide a traffic control plan that was approved by Mr. Bermudez; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the project taking longer than originally proposed to complete the second phase of the repairs, the cost exceeded the original estimate for traffic control portion of the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, these emergency repairs occurred subsequent to the adoption of the City’s 2019-20 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of the proceeds of the Stormwater Developer Impact Fees in the amount of \$27,250 will be used for the purpose of funding the emergency repairs to Valley View Road (the “Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, in connection with Phase II of this Project, the City desires to adjust its 2019-20 Stormwater Capital Program Budget to add \$27,250 to its expenditures.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Richmond, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and this City Council hereby so finds and determines.

Section 2. The Water Resource Recovery Department shall enter into a Contract with Veolia to manage on their behalf subcontracts with BayHawk, Traffic Management Inc. and for the Phase II Emergency Repairs of the Valley View Sink Hole Project for an amount not to exceed \$27,250.

Section 3. The 2019-20 Stormwater Capital Program Budget is hereby adjusted to add \$27,250 to its expenditures.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
